Edvin Öhrström trained as a sculptor under Carl Milles. Becoming mostly famous for his glass and sculptural work, Öhrström experimented with a multitude of materials and techniques. In his long-standing role as glass sculptor for Orrefors, he often produced pieces in the "ariel" technique. Among Öhrström's most noteworthy contributions is the enormous glass monolith 'Crystal - vertical accent' [1974] situated in the middle of Sergels Torg in Stockholm. Additionally, the artist has created numerous monuments in Södermalm in Stockholm.
